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About the college

Anand Vihar College for Women was established on 19th July, 1999. It is a progeny of Vanita Samaj, a society of renowned ladies committed to social cause. The college earned a strong academic reputation in a very short time. Since its inception, the college has been striving to uphold a rigorous commitment for providing quality education to its young scholars and come out with flying colors. The college anticipated on the path of imparting education to the girls' students with BCA, B. Com. and B. Com. With computer. Then the college stepped ahead to cater higher education for exhilaration of girls students with post graduation through M. Com. in 2005-06. To traverse new vistas in the field of teacher education the college initiated B. Ed. in the year 2003-04 and D. El. Ed. was anticipated in the year 2007-08 for dexterity of primary education while to emblazon professional world with competent girls' students B. B. A. was started in 2010-11. Besides this, IGNOU's study centre (B. Ed. and M. A. Education) has been running successfully. Since 2012 the College has been recognized by IGNOU for PGDEMA (post graduate diploma in educational management and administration), CPVE (Certificate programme in value education) and PGDPPED (Post graduate diploma in pre-primary education) courses to eradicate ignorance with lantern of education.

The college prospers under the expert steering of Vanita Samaj, Bhopal registered under Madhya Pradesh Society Registrikaran Adhiniyam (Registration Number 36-1961-62). The college is affiliated to Barkatullah University, Bhopal. The B. Ed. course of the college is approved by National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE) and D. El. Ed. is affiliated to both Madhya Pradesh Board of Secondary Education and NCTE. The

College has a strategic location surrounded by greenery and in the midst of fresh air on Link Road No. 1, 74 Bungalows, Tulsi Nagar, and Bhopal. It is located in the vicinity of New Market, one of the major markets of Bhopal and is about 3.5 km from Habibganj Railway Station. The lush green college campus is spread over 2.15 acres. The accessibility to college is easy for the girls' students from all the parts of the city. The progress of the college during the last 18 years has been indeed impressive. We, today, are proud of being an educational institution renowned for preparing future girls of competence and conscience. The students of the college are nurtured by the faculty in a manner that they enshrine proficiency in the frontiers of their discipline. Their regular meeting every week resulted in the formation of VANITA SAMAJ CLUB and in 1960 Vanita Samaj club started Anand Vihar School as Montessori School with 10

students in the year 1962. Children were taught by the volunteers initially for continuous seven years. There were only two-three rooms at the present school site for running the classes. Every year one class was added and construction of school building also continued. First high school batch came out in the year 1979.

In 1999, Vanita samaj established Anand Vihar College for women to pursue on the path of higher education by imparting quality education without any discrimination and the college enshrined itself as a self sufficient, stately and promising institution. They are renowned for all-round impressive performance and role they play in the character formation among students and molding them as mature human beings.


